I am happy to provide an update from the Board of Trustees Mid-Year Meeting. The Trustees met on March 31, 2022, and reviewed the PFA finances, bylaws, and membership.

- While the PFA is in strong financial condition, the recent effects of the COVID-19 pandemic and numerous retirements have reduced the number of current, active Fellows. This could affect our future financial condition.
- The Trustees updated our guide for Section Chairs and reiterated the importance of Section Chairs as the local resource for the PFA. It is exciting to see so many Sections coming back to in-person meetings and inducting new Fellows into the PFA.
- The PFA is aspiring to accomplish a '5% in 5 years' membership recruit-

- The PFA bylaws were modified. The former bylaws stated that new PFA Fellows "must be a member of the American Dental Association." The new bylaws state that new PFA Fellows "must be a member of the American Dental Association or a similar dental organization." This is reflective of our international Sections and the change also allows leaders who are active only in other dental organizations both far and wide (e.g., National Dental Association, Association of Women Dentists, Academy of General Dentistry, World Dental Federation) to become PFA Fellows.
- New leadership courses will be uploaded to the PFA website soon. As a member benefit, PFA Fellows have access to free CE on a variety of leadership topics. Our current CE activity – Leadership in Turbulent Times – is very popular. New programs will include negotiation skills and presentation skills.
- Watch for a new-look PFA website coming soon.
- The Trustees began work on a shortterm strategic plan. As an international organization, we must continue to be responsive to across the globe as the organization grows.
- The PFA Annual Meeting is set for October 15, 2022, at the Hilton Americas Hotel in Houston, TX.

With support from all PFA Fellows and the PFA Trustees, I know we can continue to grow the PFA at an appropriate pace and continue to make the PFA the pre-eminent Dental Honor Society in the world. I look forward to hearing from you.

REPORT ON THE JOINT PFA/ACD CONTINUING EDUCATION CONFERENCE

he joint Pierre Fauchard Academy-American College of Dentists Continuing Education Conference was held between March 31 to April 2, 2022, at the Biltmore Estate in Asheville, North Carolina with attendees staying at the Inn. We began with a welcome reception at the Lioncrest Veranda, where hors d'oeuvres were served. Our CE Sessions were also held at the Lioncrest, with convenient shuttles both days. Our Friday morning session focused on Syndromic Surveillance. Topics included 'Syndromic Surveillance by the Medical Workforce' which was given by Professor Michael G. Schmidt and the second presentation, titled 'Syndromic Surveillance by the Dental Workforce: Oral Manifestations of

COVID-19', was provided by Professor Theresa Gonzales. Friday afternoon was dedicated to presentations on 'Communication Strategies for Leaders.' We continued on Saturday morning with presentations related to the COVID-19 pandemic and access to care, given by Dr. Tim Ricks, Chief Dental Officer for the U.S. Public Health Service, and Professor Amy Brock Martin. In addition, presentations on leadership skills development were provided. These included a presentation titled 'Professional Presentation Skills to Get Your Audience Moving' given by Mary Sandro from ProEdge Skills. A second presentation titled 'Negotiation Skills for Leaders' was given by Dr. Joshua Weiss, co-founder of the Global Negotiation Initiative at



Harvard University. The conference was a wonderful opportunity for participants to attend thought-provoking, informative presentations, as well as to meet in person and reconnect with friends and colleagues.
