- PFA now is firmly in the digital age: our website provides a great wealth of information and enables Academy Fellows, internationally, to interact with our Central Office in more ways than ever. What's more, we save money and increase communication by using email to reach our Fellows.

Throughout this evolution, for me, the most important aspect of PFA has been our people. All the smart and caring individuals I have met and worked with throughout the world motivated me to work hard to ensure that we achieved each goal set out for us.

The fact is, I literally grew up with PFA, having attended meetings as a youngster with my parents, especially since my father, Dr. Gary Lowder, served as PFA president. I've always been

Many accomplishments have been achieved by the talented men and women on the Pierre Fauchard Academy Board of Trustees with whom I had the privilege of working. I would like to thank each and every one of them for their actions while we were together on the Board. With thanks to: Dr. Cheri S. Hale (Central USA), Kansas, USA); Dr. Pankaj Patel (Region 11 Trustee (Africa), Kenya); Ms. Loralie Lowder (outgoing Executive Director, Logan, Utah); and, Mr. Robert Cattoi (incoming Executive Director, Rockville, MD).

This is the Board that voted to install our first woman in the Pierre Fauchard Academy Hall of Fame. Dr. Lucy Hobbs Taylor of Ohio, Iowa and Kansas was the first female in the world to earn her DDS degree, graduating in 1866. She was a

teacher, dentist, and suffragette. Dr. Taylor may be the first woman in our Hall of Fame, but she certainly won't be our last. It was with a great sense of pride that we installed Dr. Taylor's plaque in our new Pierre Fauchard Academy Hall of Fame on August 20, 2021, in our new International Headquarters. Dr. Taylor's plaque will also be installed later this year in the Pierre Fauchard Academy Hall of Fame at the University of Maryland School of Dentistry in Baltimore, Maryland.

Our Board of Trustees demonstrated leadership and made unanimous decisions. When we met in March 2020 in Little Rock, Arkansas for the Academy's Mid-year Meeting just prior to the start of the Covid-19 pandemic, the Board voted unanimously to make three changes that have changed the course of our Academy. The first vote was a relocation of our Central Office in Logan, Utah, USA to our new International Headquarters in Rockville, MD. The second vote was the establishment of an additional Foundation for our Academy. the Pierre Fauchard Academy Leadership Academy. Finally, the Board voted to do a Capital Campaign to help fund the new PFA Leadership Foundation. Additionally, under the guidance of Trustee Cheryl Billingsley and her committee, the Board established a continuing educational seminar titled "Leadership in Turbulent Times." This gives Fellows an opportunity to receive 10 hours of free continuing educational credits. This program has been very well received and is a direct Fellow benefit.

While some very exciting events have happened while I have been President, sadly so have some devastating ones. On January 25, 2021, we lost Dr. Jerry Dushkin who was our President-elect and passed away after a brief illness. Dr. Dushkin is being honored posthumously as the incoming International President for a brief time on October 13, 2021. His wife Patti will receive Jerry's Past-President's medallion with the date of October 13, 2021. Dr Dushkin's untimely death left a void in our

Academy. The Academy lost another outstanding Canadian Fellow, Dr. Barry Dolman, this Spring. Memorials to Drs. Dushkin and Dolman can be found in our new International Headquarters. The Academy lost another cherished member of our PFA family this year to COVID-19, Dr. Nira Patel an orthodontist from Kenya and wife of our Region 11 Trustee, Dr. Pankaj Patel. A commemorative plaque in memory of Nira and others lost to this devastating pandemic is displayed in the reception area of our new International Headquarters.

On August 20, 2021, PFA held its Ribbon Cutting Ceremony of our first brick

and mortar Headquarters. Our new Fauchard Room contains our new Hall of Fame, the '1936 Club' wall of donors, and many PFA artifacts. Included in these artifacts is a bronze statue of Pierre Fauchard, donated by Dr. Scott and Sheri Waugh. My favorite part of my Presidency was meeting Fellows all over the world. The warmth that I encountered was heartwarming. I would be totally remiss for not thanking my husband Rick Morales-Brewick who has been by my side in my journey through leadership in the Pierre Fauchard Academy. Thank you, Rick, I could not have done this without you. My

journey in PFA is not over. I look forward to serving you as Immediate Past-President next year and as an Officer of the Leadership Foundation.

I would like to congratulate Dr. Armyl Ba \tilde{n} ez, who will be installed as the International President of the Pierre Fauchard Academy and will lead our great Academy forward.

Again, thank you, it has been my pleasure serving the Academy.

emy. In 1995, through a generous gift from Dr. Bennes Espinach of Costa Rica, the Oral Health Foundation of the Pierre Fauchard Academy was set up. This Foundation promotes the advancement of oral healthcare globally through grants and student scholarships.

Fast forward to 2020, and the Pierre Fauchard Academy Leadership Foundation was formed. With a totally different purpose, our mission is to provide enhanced leadership training and educational benefits. Our vision is to be recognized as the most respected educator in leadership development. We have already begun this training through our online series, titled "Leadership in Turbulent Times." There are 10 modules to complete, after which you will receive 10 CE credits. This is an excellent series so please take advan-

Eighty-five years after the Pierre Fauchard Academy was created, our Academy has moved into the new ACD Headquarters in Rockville, Maryland. We are ecstatic to develop a permanent residence where Fellows from across the Globe can visit and enjoy a historical perspective of their Fellowship. To help fund our activities, we have created 4 tiers of donorship for our Capitol Campaign. These are as follows:

MEET OUR NEW INTERNATIONAL HEADQUARTERS

It is with great excitement that I write this article regarding our new International Headquarters. What started as a pipe dream is now a reality. An important fact to note is that the building is owned by the American College of Dentists Foundation and both the American College of Dentists, and the Pierre Fauchard Academy are renting space. Before negotiating the contract with the American College of Dentists Foundation a site visit was conducted by Dr. Jerry Dushkin, Dr. Cheryl Billingsley and her husband John, Executive Director Loralie Lowder, and myself. We all agreed this move would be in the best long-term interest of our great Academy. The building was purchased by 3 Fellows of the American College of Dentists: Dr. Patricia Blanton (a recipient of the Fauchard Gold Medal Award), Dr. Jerry Miller and a Fellow who wished to remain anonymous. The build-

ing was renovated from top to bottom, including a new roof, new siding, Charleston green shutters along with new windows, new carpeting, and wall coverings. The outside has been professionally landscaped.

Our Trustee Dr Cheryl Billingsley, outgoing Executive Director Loralie Lowder. incoming Executive Director Bob Cattoi and I jointly worked on our space, which we all agreed should containing blue, white, and red to represent the brand of our Academy. This was accomplished by having all the hard-surface furniture be in a white lacquer effect. The other furniture includes two red armchairs in the Executive Director's office and matching blue love seats in the Fauchard room. Accent walls have been painted in red and blue, with white plantation shutters, complimenting the color scheme. The primary office has 3 main rooms, while the Academy also has access to

three conference rooms, a mailing and packaging room, a full kitchen and three bathrooms. There is an adjacent parking lot with spaces for 15 cars.

Within our primary office, the reception room has a main desk and a file cabinet with a white leather chair. It boasts a replica of our Academy logo flanked by the logos of our two Foundations: the Pierre Fauchard Academy Leadership Foundation and the Oral Health Foundation of the Pierre Fauchard Academy. The Academy's gratitude must be extended to incoming Executive Director Mr. Bob Cattoi who found a company in Cincinnati to fabricate these large signs, then drove to Cincinnati to personally pick them up and arranged to have them hung in the reception space. On the opposing wall is an original oil painting created by Dr. Cheryl Billingsley in blue, gold, and red to represent

a flattened view of the world and to be representative of the French flag. Thank you to Dr. Billingsley for your generosity in donating this painting and the crystal chandelier in the Fauchard room.

The reception room also has a blue fabric-covered bench above which is a plaque for Dr. Nita Patel from Kenya. Dr. Patel lost her life to COVID-19 in a three-day period. She represents the many lives lost that were part of our PFA family. Future plaques will include a list of all Past Presidents of the Academy, photographs of our Executive Directors and photographs with names of the Board of Trustees that voted to take this monumental step in achieving our first brick and mortar International Headquarters. Tributes to Drs. Jerry Dushkin and Barry Dolman, both from Canada, will reside in this room.

The second and most important of the three rooms is the Fauchard room. It is in this room that our additional Pierre Fauchard Hall of Fame is located. The original Hall of Fame is still located at the University of Maryland Dental School in Baltimore, near the Dean's office, and may have to be removed in upcoming years because of renovation. Our Trustees thought it best to be prepared and voted to have a Hall of Fame located within our space. This would also allow more Fellows to enjoy the Hall of Fame with ease if they are visiting the D.C. area. Our new address, 103 North Adams, is just three blocks from the Cambria Hotel which in turn is only a four block walk from the Metro that connects the three major airports near Washington D.C. to Rockville and our new International Headquarters.

The Fauchard Room also houses the wall containing the names of the Fellows and Sections participating in the 1936 Club. On the same wall, there are two white file cabinets that have 4 special blue leather books on them. These books will contain the names of the 1936 donors and for donors giving \$596, \$89, and \$20. Giving to our Capital Campaign drive at any level is very much appreciated by the Academy. Between these white filing cabi-

nets is a 24" lighted globe representing our PFA Fellows from around the world. This was Dental World Editor Dr. Fiona Collins' idea. Flags representing the countries that the Officers and Board of Trustees are from are housed on the wall opposite the globe. These flags will be used on stage as a backdrop for our Annual Meetings.

A list of the Fauchard Gold Medal Award winners and the Elmer S. Best Award winners can be found between the two shuttered windows. The name plates are silver in color, housed on beautiful blue leucite frames. My thank you to our outgoing Executive Director Loralie Lowder for finding the company that makes these frames. There are two blue love seats that straddle a white-layered oval coffee table which is positioned under the crystal chandelier. A white half-round desk sits in front of the flags and will be an additional workstation for a third Academy employee in the future. Names of the Trade and Industry Award winners and a list of Presidential Award winners backed in blue leucite will also be in this

Academy. The 2021 Recipient of Honourary Fellowship was Mr. Kevin Desjardins for his exceptional work for the Canadian Dental Association. Dr. Howard Mark. President of the Oral Health Foundation of the Pierre Fauchard Academy, joined our virtual event from his home in Florida. Dr. Mark extended his deepest condolences on the loss of Dr. Barry Dolman and Dr. Jerry Dushkin. Each year, the Oral Health Foundation provides scholarships for a student at each of the 10 Canadian Faculties of Dentistry. Dr. Dolman's last PFA business was to donate \$10,000 back to the Oral Health Foundation. To honor Dr. Barry Dolman and Dr. Jerry Dushkin, the Canadian Region of the Pierre Fauchard Academy has established two Leadership Scholarships. Each scholarship will award \$1,000 to a dental student who exhibits exceptional leadership skills, one at the University of Montreal in memory of Barry and the second one at McGill University in memory of Jerry. May their legacies live on. Dr. Sam Sgro, (Section Chair for Quebec) presented a cheque for \$7500 to the University of Montreal to establish Dr. Dolman's memorial scholarship.

To join the exclusive 1936 Club and obtain a special wall plaque, a donation of \$1936 is made to the Leadership Foundation. The Canadian Pierre Faucha-

rd Academy is very proud that Canada boasts five 1936 Club plaques to date. Dr. Jerry Dushkin and Dr. Lisa Bentley made personal donations. PFA Canada made 2 donations in honor of Dr. Kevin Roach, Past PFA International President and Dr. Barry Dolman. The Ontario Section of the American College of Dentists purchased
