

Michigan Section Honors Scott Hodges DDS With Joseph B. Harris Mentorship Award

The Michigan Section of the Pierre Fauchard Academy is proud to announce that it will honor **Dr. Scott Hodges** on Saturday, April 20th , during our Spring Lunch Meeting in Lansing. Scott Hodges DDS has continually distinguished himself throughout his professional career through his service to his profession in a variety of leadership roles. Those roles include dentist, dental educator and mentor and community advocate.



Besides maintaining a large endodontic practice in Grand Rapids since 1988, Dr. Hodges has dedicated his life in service to others through his many mentoring roles including dental school instructor and patient outreach advocate.

After serving two years (1986-1988) as a Staff Dental Officer in the U.S. Public Health Service in Arizona, Scott returned to Michigan to practice endodontics, but remained steadfast in his commitment to serving others. Over the past 35 years, Dr. Hodges has arranged, organized and participated in numerous dental mission trips to a variety of locations throughout the world. These have included multiple trips to Gyanna, multiple trips to Alaska, Lebanon, the Dominican Republic, Mexico, Haiti, Ukraine and Costa Rica, Jordan and Uganda. Additionally, at home in Michigan, he has served as the Dental Chair for all four of the MDA Foundation's Missions of Mercy, often working tirelessly behind the scenes to keep patient care running smoothly.

Scott currently serves as an Adjunct Clinical Professor in the Graduate Endodontic Clinic at the University of Michigan School of Dentistry, as well as donates his clinical skills through the Donated Dental Services program, the Mel Trotter

Dental Clinic, Health Intervention Services and the Baxter Community Center.

Dr. Hodges has received a number of recognitions including the American Dental Association's Certificate of Recognition of Volunteer Service, the Michigan Dental Association's Public Service Award, the American Association of Endodontist's Lifetime Spirit of Service Award. Scott is a member of both the American and Michigan Association of Endodontists, the West Michigan Dental Society and the Pierre Fauchard Academy.

David Campbell New Dentist Award was established by the Michigan Section to recognize a recent graduate who has been out of dental school for five or more years and has shown exceptional leadership in promoting our profession. The award is named in honor of past Michigan Section PFA Chair, past PFA Foundation President and student mentor, Dr. M. David Campbell.

Our Michigan Section is pleased to announce that **Dr. Daniel Miller** is this year's recipient of the *M. David Campbell New Dentist Award*. Dr. Miller received his DDS from the University of Detroit School of Dentistry in 2014 and then completed a General Practice Residency at St. Vincent Charity Medical Center in 2015. He served on the pediatric clinic faculty at the UDM School of Dentistry from 2015-2016. Dr. Miller received his Certificate in Pediatric Dentistry from NYU Langone-Southern California in 2018. He currently practices pediatric dentistry at Smile Dental Partners in Grand Rapids.

Danny has committed to serving his profession through a variety of roles through both his component society and the Michigan Dental Association. For the West Michigan District Dental Society he has served on the Editorial Committee of


Michigan Section Honors Dr. Christopher Smiley with Distinguished Dentist Award

The Pierre Fauchard Academy's Distinguished Dentist Award is given at the President's discretion to Fellows of the Academy who's actions and deeds reflect the highest examples of honorary dental service be it directly for the Academy, the community, education, mentorship and/or philanthropy. This year our Michigan Section is proud to announce that Dr. Christopher Smiley will receive this award during our breakfast meeting on April 20, 2024.

Dr. Chris Smiley has had a very remarkable career working for and advocating for our profession. After graduating from the University of Michigan with a BS in Biology in 1982, he went on to receive his DDS from Marquette University in Wisconsin in 1986. He then began working with his father who had an established dental practice in Grand Rapids. It certainly wasn't long after that that Chris began getting actively involved with his district dental society. Through the 1990's and early 2000's Chris took on a variety of roles for the West Michigan Dental Society. These included serving as Membership Co-Chair, then as a member of West Michigan's Task Force on Managed

Care, their Legislative Committee, their Market Place Issues Task force, Editor of their Bulletin and even component president. He also served as either a delegate or alternate for West Michigan to the MDA House of Delegates during that period.

But his service to our profession would never stop there and Dr. Smiley continued to take on a large variety of roles for both the Michigan and American Dental Association. For the MDA, Chris has served as a member of the Committees on Annual Session, Dental PAC Board of Governors and the Committee on Governmental Affairs. He's served on the MDABoard of Trustees, been a contributing columnist and Journal Reviewer, as well as editor of the *Journal of the Michigan Dental Association*. Chris



was also a very valuable contributor to the MDA's COVID Response Workgroup facilitating Michigan's dentists return to work during the pandemic.

It can seem overwhelming when you begin to list some of Dr. Smiley's contributions and service to the American Dental Association. Besides serving multiple years as a delegate or alternate to the ADA House of Delegates, he's served as a member, consultant and even Chair of the Council on Dental Benefit Programs, as well as a member of the Evidence Based Dentistry Board Advisory Committee and has been recognized as an ADA Evidence- Based Dentistry Champion. As

such he's organized, moderated and chaired several evidence based dentistry panels and conferences sponsored by the ADA. He's additionally Chaired the ADA Quality Assessment and Improvement Subcommittee and served as a Representative and Chair to the Dental Quality Alliance.

Dr. Smiley is a Fellow of both the American and International College of Dentists, as well as the Pierre Fauchard Academy and has been the recipient of numerous awards. These include the MDA's *Young Dentist Leadership Award*, the *Distinguished Service Award* from the West Michigan Dental Society and the Evidence-Based Dentistry Practice Award from both the ADA and the American Association for Dental Research.

Dr. James Geist has been on the faculty at the University of Detroit School of Dentistry since 1986, after serving four years as an an Associate Instructor at the Indiana University School of Dentistry. A Diplomate of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology, Dr. Geist received his DDS from the University of Illinois College of Dentistry in 1979, and his MS in Oral Path and Radiology from the Indiana University School of Dentistry in 1986. After serving as Associate Professor and Interim Chairman of Radiology for many years, he was named Professor and Chairman and Director of Radiology in the Department of Diagnostic Services in 2004. In 2008 Jim was named Director of the Oral and Maxilofacial Imagining Center at UDM.

Students and faculty alike, all agree that his technological expertise coupled with expert knowledge of dental anatomy and pathology have prepared their dental undergraduate, graduate, and dental residents with the training needed to successfully complete their training and board exams.

Dr. Sweier has training in oral health care for geriatric as well as special needs adults, and is an advocate for vulnerable populations, reflected in courses she directs such as the Geriatric Dentistry course for

dental students. She received the *V.K. Volk Award* by The Michigan Society of Gerontology in 2012 for her contributions to the well-being of older Michigan
