

FROM THE DESK OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Greetings from the PFA International Headquarters. The PFA International Gala and Meeting, our annual black-tie event, was a wonderful success. This year, more than 340 people attended the Gala in New Orleans. The event was highlighted by the induction of 105 new Fellows into the PFA; the presentation of the Fauchard Gold Medal to Dr. Charles S. Greene; the presentation of the Elmer S. Best Award (international) to Sir Nairn Wilson (Professor); and the PFA Trade and Industry Award to ZimVie. This annual black-tie event is the result of many hours of work by the PFA Officers, Trustees, and Staff. I want to thank all of them for their hard work conducting this event in such a seamless manner.

The PFA Board of Trustees met for their annual Board Meeting and completed significant work. Part of this work was the election of new Officers and Trustees. I am pleased to report the following elections:

1. Dr. Cheryl Billingsley (Virginia) was elected as our International President;
2. Dr. Ghabi Kaspo (Michigan) was elected as the International President-elect;
3. Dr. Luis Felipe Jimenez (Chile) was elected as the International Vice President;
4. Dr. Jay Skolnick (New York) was elected as our new Trustee for Region 2 (NE USA);
5. Dr. Ricardo Gatbonton (The Philippines) was elected as our New Trustee for Region 9 (Asia);
6. Dr. Federico Perez Diez (Mexico) was elected as our New Trustee for Region 7 (Latin America); and,
7. Dr. Pankaj Patel will serve as Immediate Past President of the PFA and as head of the PFA Leadership Foundation.

The Board reviewed the annual financial statements of the PFA and are pleased to report a positive financial position. While the PFA budget remains tight, the hard work of the Board and Staff has kept our expenses low. The Board approved a minimal 2.5% increase in dues for all Regions in 2025 to keep up with inflation and cost-of-living.

Globally, we inducted over 500 new Fellows into our Academy across the world in 2024, of which more than 200 were inducted in Asia. The PFA Leadership Foundation continues to grow and seeks to provide funds for PFA Fellows around the world. The goal of the Foundation is to advance the leadership abilities of PFA Fellows, and this broad definition also supports the mission of the Pierre Fauchard Academy. The annual silent auction at the Gala included items donated by our Trustees and Sections from across the globe. The auction was a rousing success.

The Continuing Education Committee is working to create new online educational programs for PFA Fellows. We applied to update our AGD PACE accreditation. New

In addition, Dental Abstracts continues to be published online and is available to all PFA Fellows at no cost. As the end of our year approaches, we start the process of planning for 2025. 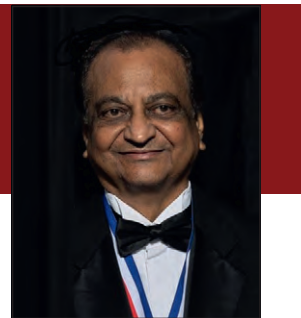

REPORT ON THE ANNUAL MEETING AND GALA OF THE PIERRE FAUCHARD ACADEMY

The Pierre Fauchard Academy Annual Meeting and Gala was held in conjunction with the American Dental Association Meeting in New Orleans in the state of Mississippi in mid-October. After the Board Meeting on Friday October 18th, two educational courses were provided for our Fellows. The first presentation was given by Ms. Nasha Knowles from Equitable Banking and the second one by Dr. Paul O'Dwyer our PFA Trustee for Europe.

The Annual PFA Gala was held on Saturday, October 19th. The evening began with a convivial cocktail hour that was enjoyed by all, accompanied by the opening of the silent auction to raise funds for the Leadership Foundation. A resounding thank you to the donors of the items that were auctioned off, ranging from unique artwork and jewelry, to exquisite wines and bourbons, to weekend retreats. During the Gala, as is customary, our Awards ceremony and induction ceremony occurred.

The *Fauchard Gold Medal* is awarded annually to an individual living in the United States of America who has made outstanding contributions to the progress and standing of the dental profession. The recipient must have a dental degree or its equivalent and must be nominated by the Committee of Past Recipients which includes all living past recipients of the medal. In addition, the nomination must be approved by the Board of Trustees.

The recipient of the 2024 Fauchard Gold Medal is Dr. Charles S. Greene, who has been involved for many years in clinical research and teaching in the area of temporomandibular disorders and orofacial pain. From 1965 to 1984, Dr. Greene worked with Dr. Daniel Laskin in the TMJ and Facial Pain Research Center at the University of Illinois Chicago (UIC), College of Dentistry. His next post spanned 1986 to 1995, when he worked at the Northwestern University Dental School with Dr. Harold Perry as co-director of their TMD Clinic.

Subsequently, Dr. Greene returned to UIC in 1995, where he served as the Director of Orofacial Pain Studies. He was a Clinical Professor in the Department of Orthodontics. Dr. Greene has contributed many articles and lectures to the orthodontic specialty in the USA

and abroad; published over 150 articles, book chapters, and abstracts; and was co-editor of a multi-author book about TMDs (Quintessence, 2006). A new multi-author book on TMDs co-edited by Dr. Greene and Dr. Laskin was released by Quintessence in 2013, and in 2015 he was one of four co-editors of a book entitled "TMD and Orthodontics" which published by Springer. He is a Life Member of the American Academy of Orofacial Pain as well as the International Association for Dental Research. Dr.

Greene retired from UIC in 2018 and is currently Clinical Professor Emeritus.

The *Elmer S. Best Memorial Award*, named in memory of the founder of the Pierre Fauchard Academy, was established by the Board of Trustees in 1962. It is awarded by the Board when the occasion is deemed proper and to no more than one recipient in any year. Recipients must be members of the dental profession from outside the United States who have made distinguished contributions of international significance to dentistry.

The 2024 recipient of the Elmer S. Best Memorial Award is Sir Nairn HF Wilson, CBE DSc (h.c.) DDent (h.c.) PhD MSc BDS DRD FCGDent FDS (Edin, Eng, Glasg) FFD FCDSHK FHEA FACD FPFA FICD FADM FKC. He is Emeritus Professor of Dentistry at King's College London and has enjoyed an illustrious career in academic dentistry, spanning more than 50 years. His many and varied appointments included as Editor of the Journal of Dentistry, Dean of the University Dental Hospital in Manchester (UK), King's College London Dental Institute and the Faculty of Dental Surgery, Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh. Uniquely, he

has also been President of the General Dental Council, the British Dental Association and the College of General Dentistry. Nairn has published extensively and received prestigious national and international prizes and awards, including two honorary doctoral degrees. Sir Nairn HF Wilson was appointed a Commander of the British Empire (CBE) in 2004, a Knight Bachelor in 2024, and has been a PFA Fellow since 1990.

The Dental Trade and Industry Award of Recognition may be presented to honor an outstanding leader in the field for contributions to dentistry and the community. Only one plaque per

year will be awarded. The recipient must be nominated by the awards committee and have the approval of the Board of Trustees, and the President presents the plaque at the PFA Gala. The 2024 recipient is ZimVie, a global life sciences leader in the dental market that develops, manufactures, and delivers a comprehensive portfolio of products and solutions designed to support dental tooth replacement and restoration procedures.

The Presidential Award of Excellence is an award to be selected and presented by the International President. Congratulations to our 2024 recipient, Dr. Lisa Bentley (Trustee for Canada) and Dr. Paul Obrock (Trustee for S.E. USA), who have worked tirelessly and with excellence on behalf of our Academy.

Honorary Fellowship in the Pierre Fauchard Academy was bestowed upon Dr. Manjul (Manny) Vasant and Mr. Robert Cattoi (Executive Director of the PFA) for their contributions to dentistry.

During the Gala dinner, we heard interesting and engaging addresses from our Board members. We held our induction ceremony for more than 100 new Fellows, where they were individually welcomed on stage, congratulated by the leadership of the PFA, and received their stoles, pins and certificates. At the end of the induction ceremony, all new Fellows took their oath. Congratulations to all of our new Fellows.

We look forward to meeting everyone who will be attending our Annual Meeting and Gala next year in October 2025 in Washington, DC.

AN INTERVIEW WITH DR. CHERYL BILLINGSLEY, INTERNATIONAL PRESIDENT OF THE PIERRE FAUCHARD ACADEMY

Why did you want to be the President of the Pierre Fauchard Academy?

As President of the PFA, I am honored to serve in this capacity, following in the footsteps of remarkable Past Presidents. We have an exceptional board of volunteers who dedicate a significant amount of their time to this organization without any compensation. I take great pleasure in viewing the "big picture" of the PFA and our esteemed profession of dentistry.

What led you to a career in dentistry?

My journey into dentistry was not a straightforward one. I initially set my sights on a career in pediatrics at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. However, the untimely passing of my father during my junior year led me to reconsider my path, and I realized that I might not be ready for the rigors of medical school at that time. This realization led me to major in dental hygiene. After receiving an excellent education at the University of North Carolina, I practiced dental hygiene for five years before attending the Medical College of Virginia (Virginia Commonwealth University School of Dentistry). My background in dental hygiene significantly aided my dental education. My journey taught me the value of resilience and the importance of adapting to life's unexpected turns.

What have you enjoyed during your time in dentistry?

I love working with my hands, and dentistry proved to be the perfect profession for me. I have enjoyed seeing the

final results of my work, and especially the happiness on my patients' faces.

What do you hope to accomplish during your presidency?

I aim to lead with honesty, openness, and transparency. We frequently communicate with our Fellows, and I would like to enhance those communications further. My goals are, firstly, to increase the number of PFA Fellows worldwide and, secondly, to improve our PFA Leadership Foundation contributions – these fund our continuing education, scholarships, Leadership Foundation assistance, and marketing. My other two goals are to enhance communication with our Fellows and to expand our portfolio of educational leadership courses for our Fellows.
